Job Description Part-Time Youth Pastor Bay Park Baptist Church

Involvement to consist of:

- 1. Plan and coordinate youth activities in conjunction with youth sponsors. Plan a month in advance, preferably three months. Disciple and recruit youth sponsors to help as needed.
- 2. Be in charge of Wednesday night youth activities Assure that the evening has spiritual content and challenge with the aim to lead youth to salvation in Jesus Christ and to help others grow in their faith.
- 3. Lead a weekly youth small group Bible Study in which discipleship takes place.
- 4. One on One discipleship meet youth one on one (e.g. attend youth sports games when possible, keep in touch through phone calls. Be available for spiritual counsel. Encourage and give leadership by incorporating youth into church)
- 5. Have set hours during the week when youth can call. Set time schedule in church. Punctuality and consistency is required.
- 6. Be involved in reaching out to families of the youth in conjunction with the overall church program, thus building the foundation for a solid youth ministry.

Accountability:

- 1. Closely work with church leadership. Accountable to pastor and indirectly to Church Board/Church.
- 2. To meet with pastor and report weekly, discuss ministry and share ministry progress as well as concerns.

Education:

Bachelor Degree (or working towards one) from a recognized Bible College.

Time:

Roughly 20 hours weekly. Often, a week will consist of more than 20 hours (within reason) as volunteer hours come into play as for any lay person involved in ministry. There is a possibility of expanding to full-time at a later date.

Vacation:

The above job description describes the position in general terms. It will be adjusted to the needs of the church taking into consideration the gift mix of the Youth Pastor and time involved in different areas.
